Arts Programming Support Announced for 2010-2011

The United Arts Council of Raleigh and Wake County announces the investment of over a quarter million dollars in grants support for arts programming in the current fiscal year. Additionally, grants for the Artists in Schools program and Regional Artists Grants will be announced in September and December, respectively.

United Arts awarded 35 grants totaling \$264,838 to support artists, schools, and arts programming to 29 organizations in Wake County. Qualifying nonprofit organizations, as well as schools and Wake municipalities, were eligible to apply for grants to support arts programming occurring between July 1, 2010, and June 30, 2011.
